#### **Use of Courts**

- 1. All members will play squash or racketball according to ES published rules and regulations.
- 2. All persons using courts will wear non-marking shoes on court and appropriate clothing.
- 3. Knock on court door and await acknowledgement before entering court.
- 4. Courts are for the playing of squash or racketball only and **all other uses** must be cleared with the Committee.

### Membership

- 5. Members will complete an application form in full, and advise the Committee of any changes.
- 6. Members will pay the appropriate full annual membership fee within 14 days of the due date or may be subject to a fine not exceeding the new members' administration fee
- 7. Refunds will only be given pro-rata during the first 3 months after renewal date. Thereafter the full annual fee is non refundable.
- 8. Membership suspension is given in extreme cases of injury, on application and with approval by the committee. Notify the Committee, in writing, as soon as possible. No adjustment will be made in retrospect.

- 10. Harrow Squash Club will not tolerate poor behaviour, bad language or aggression during any of its squash activities.
- 11. Juniors (U18) must wear eye protection on court as recommended by England Squash and Racketball.
